1 MHFD WORKS WITH LOCAL GOVERNMENTS TO PREPARE A FLOOD HAZARD AREA DELINEATION (FHAD) includes hydraulic model, floodplain mapping and report



2 MHFD BOARD OF DIRECTORS PASSES RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE FHAD



4 MHFD WORKS WITH FEMA REGION VIII TO DETERMINE WHICH RECENTLY COMPLETED FHADS WILL BE A PART OF A NEW PHYSICAL MAP REVISION (PMR)

3 STATE (CWCB) DESIGNATES THE FLOODPLAIN
MHFD Board of Directors passes resolution adopting FHAD (at this point, most communities are able to regulate the newly designated floodplain)



5 MHFD SUBMITS DATA TO FEMA FOR TECHNICAL REVIEW

6 FEMA WORKS WITH MHFD TO RESOLVE QUESTIONS AND GET FHAD DATA INCORPORATED INTO FEMA FLOOD HAZARD PRODUCTS

7 FEMA PROVIDES DRAFT FLOOD HAZARD MAP UPDATES TO MHFD AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS FOR REVIEW AND COMMENT PRIOR TO COMPLETION OF PRELIMINARY PMR PRODUCTS

Documents FEMA Approval & Sets Effective Date for PMR

FEMA FIS & FIRM used for Regulation & Flood Insurance
